Important Instructions for sections 7, 8, 13 and 14

- 7) Registrants who are submitting this form by mail and are registering to vote for the first time: If you do not supply any of the information required by section 7, or the information you provide cannot be verified, you will be asked to provide a COPY of a current and valid photo ID, or a document with your name and current address on it to avoid having to provide identification at the polling place.
Note: ID Numbers are Confidential and will not be released by any governmental agency. Any person who uses such numbers illegally shall be subject to criminal penalties.
- 8) If you are homeless, you may complete section 8 by providing a contact point or the location where you spend most of your time.
- 13) You may declare a political party affiliation or you may declare to be unaffiliated, regardless of any prior party affiliation. If you are a previously affiliated voter who wants to change political party affiliation or become unaffiliated, you must file this form no later than 55 days before the primary election in order to vote in the primary election. Completing section 13 is OPTIONAL and will not affect the acceptance of your voter registration application.
- 14) If you wish to receive a Mail-In Ballot for all future elections, mark the appropriate box in section 14. You will continue to receive Mail-In Ballots for all future elections until you request otherwise in writing to your County Clerk's office.

You can register to vote if:

- You are a United States citizen.
- You are at least 17 years of age.*
- You will be a resident of the State and county 30 days before the election.
- I am not serving a sentence of incarceration as the result of a conviction of any indictable offense under the laws of this or another state or of the United States.

*You may register to vote if you are at least 17 years old but cannot vote until reaching the age of 18.

Registration Deadline: 21 days before an election

Your County Commissioner of Registration will notify you if your application is accepted.
If it is not accepted, you will be notified on how to complete and/or correct the application.

- Nicknames won't match: Kate won't match Katherine, Jim won't match James, etc.

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Polling Place Locations

Provisional Ballot

Normally a provisional ballot is cast by a voter whose eligibility to vote cannot be confirmed at the polls on Election Day. For the November 3rd General Election all voters, except those with a disability, are required to vote using a paper provisional ballot. If, after the election, it is determined that the voter who cast the provisional ballot was eligible to vote, the ballot will be counted.

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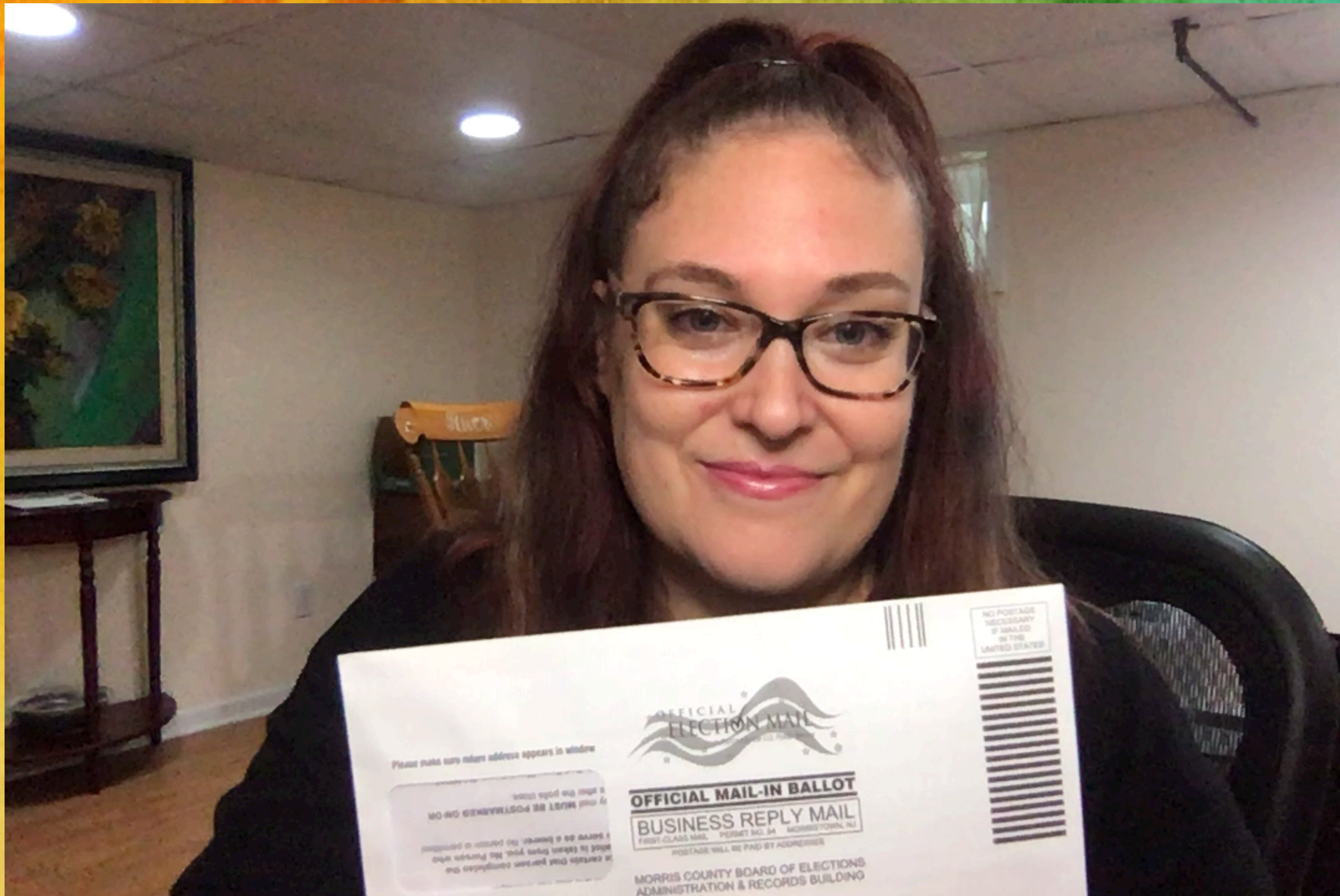

Track Your Ballot!

Track My Ballot

You can track the progress of your ballot. Here's how: Start by signing into your personal New Jersey Voter Registration System account information.

[Log Into Your NJ Voter Information System Account](#)

If do not already have a NJ Voter Information System account, you will need to set up your account.

You can use your Voter ID, NJ Driver's License Number or the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number to sign up for your account. It is suggested that you use your Voter ID. You can find it by using the "[Am I Registered/Voter Search Tool](#)." Or you can contact your [County Election Officials](#).

[Set Up Your NJ Voter Information System Account](#)

*Or you can also call your [County Election Officials](#) to track your Mail-In Ballot.

Either return your ballot by mail, deliver it to your county Board of Elections office, place it in one of the secure ballot drop boxes located throughout your county, or bring it to your polling place. Remember only you, the voter, can bring your ballot to your polling place on Election Day.

"Can I vote if I have a guardian?"



Definitely!!

You can vote even if you are not your own guardian!

"If I am registered, do I have to
vote?"



Nope!

You SHOULD vote but you do not have to!

"I heard that vote-by-mail ballots are not secure. Is this true?"



FALSE!!!

Tampering with mail is a federal crime. Mail-in voting is taken very seriously and is secure.
